

Renowned US Four-Star General Stanley A. McChrystal Joins LRI Board of Governors

Following his significant achievements in the military arena, perhaps most notably as commander of the U.S. and International Forces in Afghanistan and leader of the Joint Special Operations

Command (JSOC), General McChrystal founded The McChrystal Group "to deliver innovative leadership solutions to businesses globally in order to help them transform and succeed in challenging, dynamic environments." Widely lauded as a "warrior-scholar," General McChrystal is the author of several books, including *Team of Teams: New Rules of Engagement for a Complex World; Leaders: Myth and Reality;* and most recently *Risk: A User's Guide*. A four-star general with an MA in national security and strategic studies from the Naval War College, General McChrystal is passionate about the value of history for contemporary insight. He is a senior fellow at Yale University's Jackson Institute for Global Affairs.

General McChrystal commented "as business and risk environments become more complex and ambiguous, I am pleased to support the LRI in its initiatives designed to assist decision makers facing these challenges. The institute's commitment to using history to develop a better understanding of the deep context shaping these environments and equipping long-run perspectives are important elements in improving decision making."
